

Norrie Beswick - Calvert

"Opening your own making space is a bit scary, not just because inevitably it's invariably on the messy side, but also because it's a bit like people looking inside your head. Having said, that it's lovely to share, and so I cordially invite you to come take a look at the things that I'm currently inspired by and I will be demoing screenprinting that relates to my current practice, for anyone curious about this specific printing technique"





Kate Tidmarsh

"I enjoy recording my surroundings in sketches and photographs, which I then use as starting points for my experimental printmaking. My prints are all produced in my studio by hand, primarily on my etching press. I use a variety of techniques including collagraph and monoprinting, often working to produce a series of related prints. These are all individually inked, resulting in unique works of art, often utilising unusual materials and techniques. Currently I am investigating printing from recycled packaging, as well as incorporating plaster into my final pieces."

Jenny Curwen

"I have been pursuing my photographic art since studying at Southport Art College. When I signed up I soon found myself immersed in projects and different techniques. I discovered the miracle of photography, that in a single moment, time can be frozen and saved forever. I love the excitement of capturing the image and the immense pleasure of seeing it in print. I am inspired by nature and my favourite type of photography is Macro exploring colours and shapes, getting in close and seeing the tiny details within. I like to experiment with water droplets on flowers and to capture vivid images of oil floating on water. To look deep inside soap bubbles and capture ever changing shapes."


Ainsdale & Birkdale Art Club
